Global Warming

Global warming refers to the increase of the earth's average temperature due to increasing amounts of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere. Scientists agree that this is mainly a result of human activity. Burning fossil fuels like oil and coal causes greenhouse gases such as carbon dioxide to escape into the air and trap heat on the planet surface.

There are already some changes happening because of global warming. As temperature is increasing ice caps are melting, sea level is rising and some animals are becoming endangered or moving to new homes because their natural habitat is disappearing. If the warming gets worse, as scientists expect, some kinds of plants and animals will become extinct. In the future the climate will change dramatically and there may be more storms and floods. Sea levels may rise so much and some areas may become so dry for farming that people may have to move from the places where they live.

All humans can help reduce global warming. They should use public transport as much as possible and use alternative energy sources such as solar or wind power to heat or cool their houses. Another way to reduce greenhouse gases is to reduce deforestation, the cutting down of trees. Trees soak up carbon dioxide from the air, so having lots of trees around is good for the atmosphere and forests are home to many kinds of plants and animals.

The best way to help slow down global warming is to put less carbon into the air by using less fossil fuel - something that is easy to say, but hard to do!
