# Technology Changes Our Lives

Computers changed life for all of us. Two computer inventions in particular changed the way we communicate: email and the World Wide Web.

Email, or electronic mail, <u>allows</u> us to send messages without paper or stamp. In an <u>instant</u>, a person at a computer anywhere in the world can send and <u>receive</u> messages. Ray Tomlinson sent the first email in 1971. He worked for a company that was doing projects for the U.S. military. Their <u>goal</u> was to create a new way for people to communicate with each other.

The company created a network called ARPANET. Computer programs helped organize email on the network. Once only the military used email. Now anyone can send and receive email. Today, there are about 800 million email accounts.

The invention of this network led to the development of the World Wide Web. Tim Berners-Lee created the 'web' in 1990. It allows us to connect to people and businesses around the world. It lets us do things in seconds that used to take a long time. We can do research. We can shop online. We can go to different websites and compare prices. We can find maps and plan trips. We can buy airplane tickets or get hotel coms without making a phone call.

Computers make our lives easier. Now, we can do almost anything without leaving our desks.
