Read the text below and do all the exercises that follow:

Helen Keller was born in 1880 in Alabama, USA. She was a perfectly normal baby but as a result of a terrible illness at the age of two, she became deaf and blind. When Helen could not communicate she became wild and unhappy. She kicked and screamed, and her parents did not know how to deal with her. When Helen was seven, her father was so worried about her that he wrote to the Perkins Institute for the Blind in Boston asking for help. They sent Anne Sullivan, a young teacher who had already taught other children that were not able to see or hear. Anne taught Helen to read by drawing the letters of the words on her hand. They worked together for many hours every day until Helen began to understand and managed to put words and names to the things she touched.

After three years Helen learnt to read and write in Braille. By the time Helen was 16 she had also learnt to speak. In 1904 Helen graduated from Radcliffe College and decided to help other deaf and blind people. She never got tired of her work. She gave hundreds of lectures and wrote many books. She helped disabled people believe in themselves. She became famous all over the world. Helen Keller died in 1967 at the age of 87.
